Did You Know

What do the letters "I.N.R.I." over Jesus on the cross mean?

"So they took Jesus, and carrying the cross himself, he went out to what is called the Place of the Skull, in Hebrew, Golgotha. There they crucified him, and with him two other, one on either side, with Jesus in the middle. Pilate also had an inscription written and put on the cross. It read, 'Jesus the Nazorean, King of the Jews'" (John 19:16-19). In Latin, the language of the Romans, Pilate's inscription read "Jesus Nazaranus Rex Judaeorum", which is often shortened to "I.N.R.I.".

Seven Sisters Apostolate


