# SACRED HEART NEWS

I was visiting a friend and suddenly her phone started ringing like crazy. She was overwhelmed by the persistence of the caller. I asked her to take the call for a potential emergency. She answered Hello, who is calling? It was a young girl trying to call her mom to pick her up after school. Obviously, the young girl was confused and did not know to whom she was calling. She stated that she got her new phone for Christmas, and she forgot to lock her mom's number in her contact. She was dialing randomly a number very similar to her mother's.

We are familiar with scam calls, solicitors, robot calls and many other kinds of calls that do not take us anywhere. There is a call so important in our lives, it happens when Jesus calls us by our names not just to follow Him but also to help Him in the mission of the Church. Jesus does not call us just to follow Him. We must configure our lives, our minds, and our hearts with HIS!

We must answer His call and be ready to be prepared and transformed by Jesus' life, example and message. I found a phrase that says: "God comes among us. God calls us. God asks for the best from us."

Jesus does not call the best people or the best community. He calls those who are willing to be transformed and redeemed, but also willing to help Jesus to transform the world.

Jesus called a few men...Jesus called us, and two things must happen: we must take action and we must drop whatever we are holding onto in this life to secure our place in heaven.

We are called to FOLLOW JESUS but not just to love Him. We have the responsibility of promoting the values of the kingdom such as mercy, justice, wholeness and hope for everyone.

Jesus is calling us every day. But his call involves focusing on God's plan, to change, and to serve towards God's plan. It is not going to be easy, but we must keep trying to preach and proclaim the Good News.

Do not be afraid to answer God's call and to serve Him. It is a blessing and a privilege to serve Him and to answer His call with a generous heart. It is so worth it to FOLLOW HIM. It is so worth it to drop everything including our personal interests.

FOLLOW ME is our call and our VOCATION. We can answer that call every day and allow Jesus to guide us. He knows we are not perfect, and He knows where He is leading us to. Fortunately for us we do not have to ask like my friend WHO IS CALLING PLEASE?

Jesus will heal our brokenness and will help us to use our gifts and talents for God's kingdom.

Are you ready to answer His call?

Are you ready to drop everything for HIM and make him your main priority?

Lord, give us a generous heart to answer your call every day.

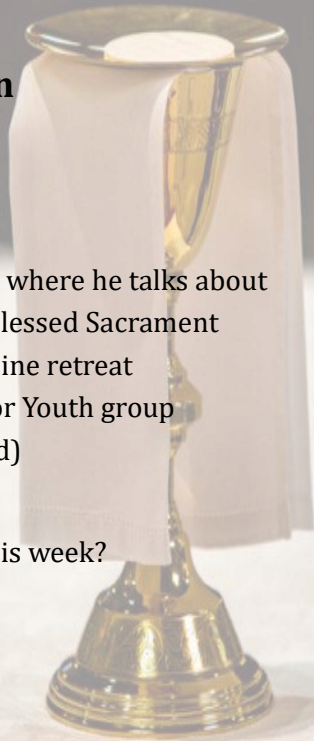

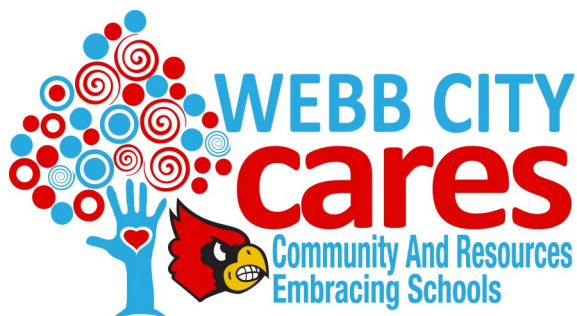
