We will not have Tuesday & Thursday Masses this week or next. Please note this coming Tuesday & Thursday we will have 8am Rosary followed by Morning Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours at 8:30am.

The Liturgy of the Hours is the Church's official prayer and is the highest form of prayer after the Mass. It is an ancient, structured way of praying Scripture throughout the day, focusing especially on the Psalms. It harkens back to the Jewish custom of praying at fixed hours during the day, a practice continued by the Church. The Liturgy of the Hours is not only for the ordained and vowed religious. It is the prayer of the entire Church. The term "Hours" refers to the time of day at which particular prayers of the Liturgy of the Hours are prayed, not to the amount of time it takes to pray that particular Hour. Morning Prayer, not to be confused with the Morning Offering prayer, takes about 15 minutes. We will offer Morning Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours in the absence of the Eucharistic Liturgy on Tuesday and Thursday mornings at 8:30 am while Fr. Allen is away. Please join in this beautiful prayer.
