# SACRED HEART NEWS

Welcome to our 5th Sunday in Ordinary time. It is the weekend of HEALING AND HOPE.

The readings remind me of a song I like a lot: WE REMEMBER. My favorite verse says: "Here, a million wounded souls are yearning just to touch you and be healed. Gather all your people and hold them to your heart."

We all need some type of healing and restoration, Jesus knows that! We are searching for Jesus, and we are searching for answers and for HOPE. I hope you noticed in the Gospel a powerful line that says: "EVERYONE IS LOOKING FOR YOU." Are you among those looking for Jesus today because you need peace, hope and healing?

Jesus found out that someone was sick, and He took action immediately. But we know by experience that is not the case all the time. Sometimes it takes time and patience to get the answer to our prayers. Sometimes we need to allow Jesus to accept our prayers and wait for HIS time with a hopeful heart.

"EVERYONE IS LOOKING FOR YOU..." reminds us that many brothers and sisters share the same need of healing in their lives.

If you pay attention to the readings this coming Sunday, you will see 3 different moments...a totally hopeless man called Job....a passionate man called Paul asking to share the Good News with others; and a very sick and weak woman I think we share a lot of Job; and with the season we feel a lot like Simon's mother-in-law...fever, powerless, weak, tired and weary.

We are too familiar with the flu season, but this year has been so different. I was very sick myself and I forgot how many times I searched for Jesus and asked Him to help me and to heal me. I knew He was right there with me but with the frustration of my illness I got distracted.

"EVERYONE IS LOOKING FOR YOU." Let us keep looking for Jesus when we feel in the middle of misery like Job. When we feel like nobody wants to listen to Jesus and His message. Like the disciples who acted as soon as they found Simon's mother-in-law ill. They approached Jesus and made Him aware of the situation. Jesus took her hand, helped her up." Jesus did 2 concrete actions to help the woman: walked and approached her and touched her. By touching her Jesus showed her His love, His acceptance and then He did the healing.

No doubt Jesus touched many lives with His presence and His ministry but also with His gentle touch. Several times the power of His presence or the power of His commands were enough. But a lot of times ``touching" the person was a critical part of His ministry. He touched the eyes of a blind man. He touched the ears and the tongue of someone. He touched a leper too.

"Here, a million wounded souls are yearning just to touch you and be healed. Gather all your people and hold them to your heart. "

Jesus heals us.... Jesus touches us... We need you more than ever....
