SACRED HEART NEWS

Welcome to Our Ordinary time. It is a great set of readings this weekend. We now left behind Christmas and the end of the Year celebrations to start doing two things: going back to our routine and daily life, and second, to embrace our priorities and resolutions for the next twelve months. I hope many of us set personal goals for the New Year and learn how to manage our time properly and wisely. Have you reflected on the things we spend our time on? How do you spend or invest your time in this life?

A recent study shows that in today's world we are too obsessed with "OUR TIME." We struggle more than ever with our free time, the amount of time we spend with family and friends, and consequently, we struggle to make and dedicate time to God and FOR GOD. WE have time and we squeezed our schedule to accommodate people and events, but nothing related to God.

Recently I was helping a person during spiritual direction, and he gave me his permission to share his story. He is struggling with His spiritual life but mainly not having time for prayer. I asked Him: have you tried anything? His answer shocked me: I haven't done my personal prayer and I have not prayed for the last 10 months...

It is impossible to grow in our faith, our relationship with God, our relationship and communion with the Church without prayer and our sacramental life.

We must slow down and learn to spend time in solitude with the Lord. We must evaluate our life and routine and check the things we spend our time on earth in preparation to SPEND OUR TIME IN ETERNITY.

What is keeping you too busy and too distracted?

It will be nice if we embrace Samuel's words in prayer: "SPEAK, FOR YOUR SERVANT IS LISTENING."

The Lord invites us to be with Him, to spend time with Him. I know by experience that I can talk to Him and share my ups and downs, my worries, and uncertainties, and ask for His advice and guidance. Once I meet with Him there is a sense of comfort, peace, joy, and hope in my heart.

Accept the Lord's invitation, "COME, AND YOU WILL SEE."

Accept His invitation and I promise you won't be disappointed.

We must have the desire and the humility to approach Him.

Let us strive this week to SPEND QUALITY TIME WITH JESUS.

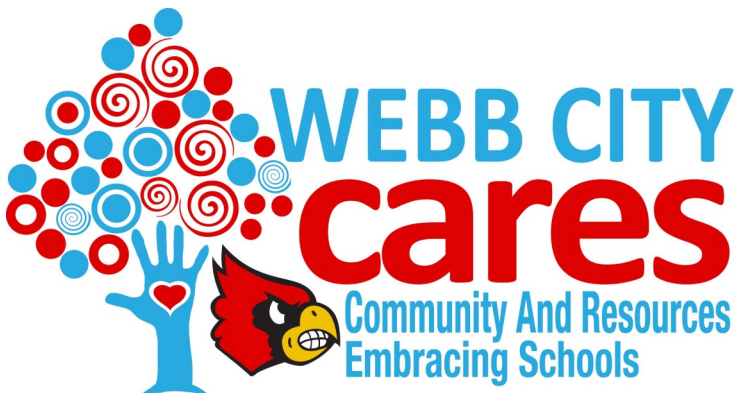
Webb City Cares Donations Needed

Lists of these items are also available in the parish hall on the front of the CARES bins, where food items may be placed.

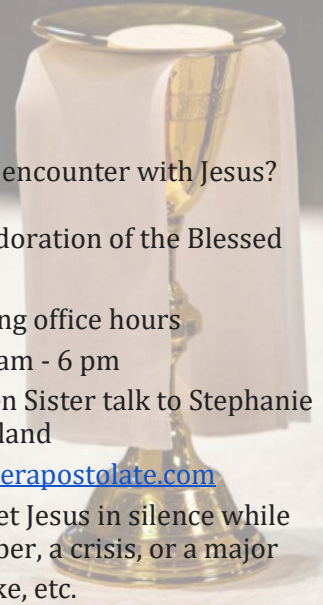

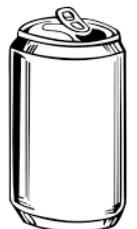


